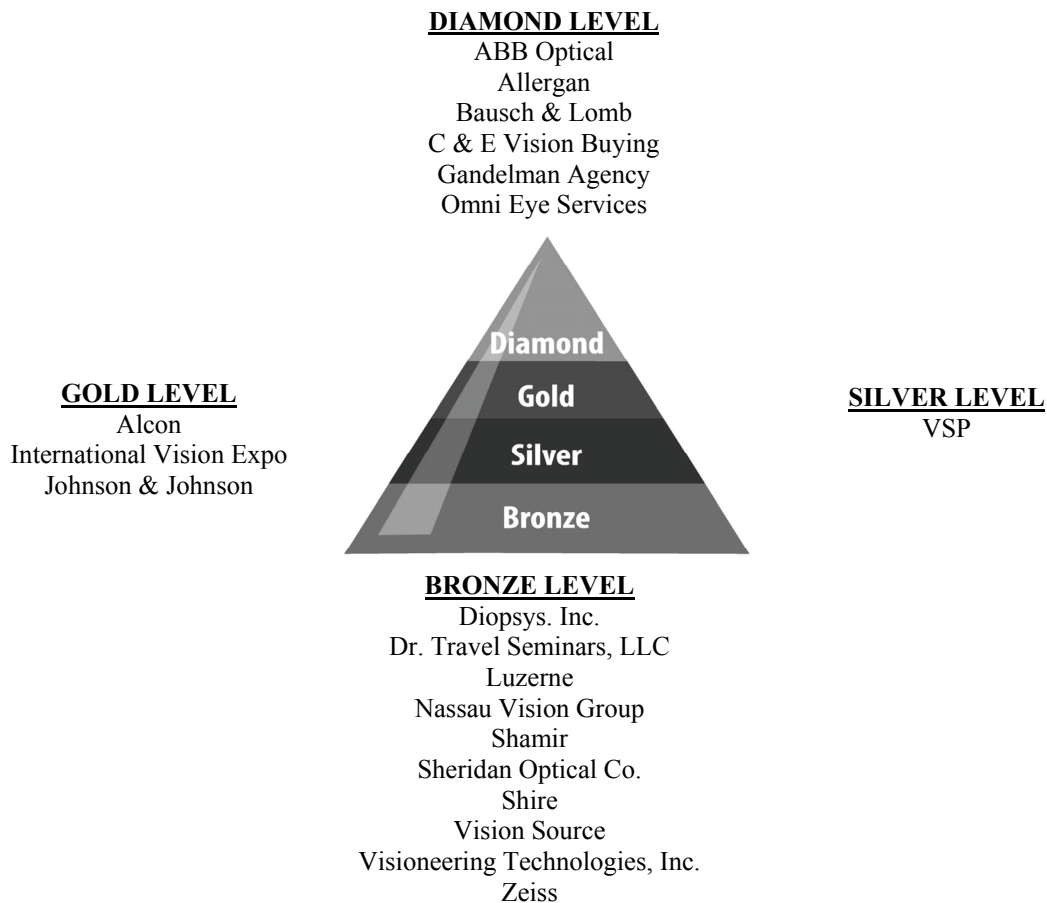

MEET OUR SPEAKERS

► **David M. Krumholz, OD, FAAO** — earned his OD degree from the SUNY State College of Optometry, then completed a Residency in Primary Eye Care at the Pennsylvania College of Optometry. Currently, he is an Associate Professor at the SUNY State College of Optometry where he teaches in the didactic program, performs research, and is an attending clinician in the College's teaching clinics. He taught the course *Clinical Medicine & Systemic Disease* for many years, which was a survey of systemic diseases and their inter-relationship with the eye. He is now responsible for teaching the *Gross Human Anatomy* course at the College. He was awarded the State University of New York Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Teaching in 2001, and the New York State Optometric Association's Optometric Educator Award in 2014. Dr. Krumholz is a Fellow of the American Academy of Optometry and the Optometric Retina Society. He has authored or co-authored over 70 scientific papers, presentations, and textbook chapters, as well as having served as a peer reviewer for several journals in the field. He has lectured extensively locally, nationally, and internationally in the areas of ocular and systemic diseases at scientific meetings and in continuing education programs. For over 25 years he has been in private practice with an ophthalmic surgeon in Brooklyn, New York specializing in secondary and tertiary vitreo-retinal care. A uveitis specialist has recently joined the practice expanding the scope to include ocular immunology and ocular inflammatory diseases.

► **Vincent R. Vicci, Jr., OD, DPNAP, FNORA** — is a 1981 doctoral graduate of the Pennsylvania College of Optometry in Elkins Park, PA. He has worked extensively in the area of visual deficits associated with traumatic brain injuries, stroke, and other neurologically challenging conditions. He is affiliated and founder of several Vision Clinics at the Kessler Institute for Rehabilitation (West Orange, Saddle Brook and Chester) and the Extended Recovery Unit of the Robert Wood Johnson Jr. Rehabilitation Institute at the John F. Kennedy Hospital in Edison, NJ. He has received multiple awards within his field of study including the "Excellence in Education" Award from Cranford High School, the "Advancement of Neuro-Optometric Rehabilitation" Award, and the "New Jersey Optometric Association" Scientific Award for his work in the area of traumatic brain injuries. Dr. Vicci is founding member of the Neuro-Optometric Rehabilitation Association (NORA) and has served as the Optometric Extension Program Foundation (OEPF) N.J. State Director from 1985-1992, Secretary of the Neuro-Optometric Rehabilitation Association (NORA) from 1990-1993, and as the President of the NORA from 1993-1997. He serves on the Advisory Board and is a Council Member of NORA and was inducted into the National Academy of Practitioners (NAP) in August of 2006. He obtained his fellowship in the Neuro-Optometric Rehabilitation Association in April of 2013.
