- ▶ Diane Adamczyk, O.D. is a PCO graduate and currently the Director of Residency Education at SUNY, State College of Optometry. She did her residency at the Newington Veterans Administration Hospital. In addition to being at SUNY since 1986 and she also had worked in a private practice for many years. Dr. Adamczyk lectures internationally and has written articles, chapters and coauthored the textbook, Primary EyeCare in Systemic Disease.
